### **ACTING FOR MOTION CAPTURE**

Familiarise yourself with the performance styles, physical demands and specific terminology of motion capture shoots. The first two days will be taught in our acting studios at Downside Road. The remaining days will be taught at CAMERA, Bath University's cutting edge motion capture studio, where you will experience filming with equipment such as motion capture suits and headmounted cameras.

## **DESIGN A PLAY IN FIVE DAYS**


MON 29 IUL - FRI 2 AUG 2024 / COURSE FEE: £570

Transform a piece of dramatic text into visual concepts for design over five days. Held in the School's design studios, this course offers a practical exploration of the fundamental principles behind designing sets and costume for theatre performances. You will construct a scale model of a theatre space, experiment with various materials and gain practical insights into creating design portfolios.



MON 19 - FRI 23 AUG 2024 / COURSE FEE: £570

This course provides an introduction to the creative process of directing a stage performance. You'll develop an understanding of a director's role and relationship with actors and members of the production team. The course covers practical techniques for analysing and interpreting text, collaborating effectively on productions and directing both adapted and devised projects.





INTRODUCTION TO PROP MAKING

WED 28 - FRI 30 AUG 2024 / COURSE FEE: £340

Create imaginative larger-than-life props for theatre, film and TV productions with this hands-on course. You'll learn essential skills in carpentry, laser-cutting, clay sculpting, silicone casting and mould making. Under the guidance of our expert tutors, you'll master the use of hand tools and workshop machines while working in a safe environment.

### INTRODUCTION TO PLAYWRITING

WED 11 - FRI 13 SEPT 2024 / COURSE FEE: £340

This course is a fast-paced introduction to the craft of writing for theatre and live performances. You'll gain a grounding in the core elements of playwriting: dramatic action, character, dialogue, location and structure. The course will provide a supportive and nurturing environment where you can share ideas openly, build your confidence and obtain constructive feedback on your writing.



The ten-week Foundation Course is designed for those interested in beginning a career in acting, improving their performance skills and abilities, and learning from industry professionals. This full-time course will immerse you in the life and culture of a leading conservatoire drama school, pursuing a curriculum which mirrors that of current BA and MFA students. On this course. you will have the opportunity to work with BOVTS staff members, alongside practitioners who are active in the theatre, film and TV industry.
